

Delightful Decorations

(Shoebbox Swap – November 2009)

- Base cardstock: Basic Black (5.5" x 8.5")
- 2nd layer: Rose Red (5.25" x 4")
- 3rd layer: Polka Dot Acetate from Night & Day Specialty Designer Paper (4" x 4")
- 4th layer: Basic Black (2.5" x 2.25")
- 5th layer: Whisper White (2.25" x 2" and scrap for ornament)
- Inks: Basic Black Craft, Basic Black marker, Rose Red marker
- Stamp Sets: Delightful Decorations, Christmas Punch
- Accessories/Embellishments: Vintage black brads, Rose Red grosgrain ribbon, ornament punch, Paper Piercing template and Paper Piercer, Crystal Clear embossing powder, heat gun, embossing buddy, mini glue dots, dimensionals
- Tips: Stamp the sentiment several times on scrap paper to make sure the oval line of the stamp isn't moist. Use the Rose Red marker to color "Christmas" and the swirl on the sentiment stamp. Huff on the stamp. Use the Basic Black marker to color the rest of the sentiment. Huff on it and stamp on Whisper White.
Emboss the ornament with Basic Black craft ink and Crystal Clear embossing powder. Punch out with ornament punch. Tie a bow with the Rose Red ribbon; make it small, trim ends, and attach mini glue dot.



Score the acetate at 3.5" on one side. Attach the ½" side with 3 mini glue dots on the back side of the Rose Red CS. Attach 2 more glue dots to the acetate to hold it down in the center of the acetate where the sentiment and ornament piece will go.
Attach brads.
Attach sentiment with adhesive.
Attach ornament with dimensionals.
