

# Help for Heather Stamp a Stack Event

Stamp Sets: Because I Care

Ink Pads: Jet Black Stazon, Bashful Blue, So Saffron, Marina Mist, Certainly Celery

Card Stock (CS):

- Bashful Blue (4.25" x 11" and 4" x 3" and 2.25" x 4")
- Naturals White (4" x 5.25" and 3.75" x 2.75")
- Delicate Dots DSP (retired) (2" x 4")

Embellishments: Champagne Mist shimmer paint

Accessories: aquapainter (or blender pen), an OLD blender pen

## Directions:

1. Stamp hydrangea in Black Stazon on smaller Naturals White CS.
2. Watercolor hydrangea. Start with the lightest color (So Saffron) and dab it onto flower. Follow with Bashful Blue, then touch up with Marina Mist. Be careful not to rub the paper too much as it will pill and curl. Dabbing the aquapainter is your best bet. And don't be afraid to leave small white spaces here and there!
3. Watercolor the leaves and stem with Certainly Celery. Set aside to dry.
4. Assemble remaining pieces of card.
5. Stamp sentiment in bottom right corner of hydrangea layer.
6. Finish assembling card.
7. Shake the container of shimmer paint. Remove the cap. You will grab the shimmer paint from the CAP!
8. With the old blender pen, grab some shimmer paint from the cap and add highlights to the flower and stem as desired. Let dry.
